What You Heard in the Word

- Jesus was the Messiah—the Savior—God first spoke of in the Garden of Eden and the one the prophets prophesied about throughout the Old Testament. The New Testament writers confirmed Jesus is the Promised One.
- Simeon rejoiced when he first saw Jesus. He knew Jesus was the fulfillment of the prophecies and would bring God's truth to the whole world.
