

Brother ,

The wrongful death lawsuit on behalf of the family of Tonya Focht who was killed during a fight between 3 IOMC members and one civilian named Mark Gross is coming close to trial. That trial is set for February. The second wrongful death suit for the Mendoza family for the death of the Mongol in Denver is set for trial one month later on March 18.

The IOMC is paying for the defense of each individual involved in the fight resulting in Tonya's death plus the costs of defending the IOMC. This includes the defense of Tim (Munch) Martin. It is now public record so everyone can read the complaint. You can read the complaint filed in the Pennsylvania court using the link below:

In this complaint it is clearly explained Tim (Munch) Martin is a convicted statutory rapist who served time in a detention facility. He is the one directly responsible for the punch, push, shove, or whatever force that caused Tonya to get run over by a car and killed. He admitted to the statutory rape conviction under oath in November 2016. The IOMC bylaws are crystal clear regarding sex offenders not being allowed in the club. The Iron Order leaders knew about his conviction since last November. They decided the Iron Order membership didn't need to know anything about this lawsuit so they chose not to tell them about this conviction. Their leaders chose to let Tim (Munch) Martin remain in their club as a full patched member violating their own bylaws and exposing their club to the risks involved in this lawsuit and the reputation of their club as being a law abiding club. They continue to pay this man's defense costs which are well over \$100,000 to date.

The IOMC will be paying for Kong's defense in the Mongol shooting plus the defense of the IOMC. The IOMC cannot sustain the legal costs for both of these lawsuits. The Mendoza case will start depositions this month. Every deposition requires flights for their leaders to Denver or Phoenix and legal representation. The combined costs for these suits will be in the hundreds of thousands of dollars. The light at the end of the tunnel is not sunshine, it is a train heading directly for the IOMC. Bankruptcy is sure to be around the corner.

The Iron Legacy MC has always had open doors to IOMC members who wished to patch over to us. Unfortunately we will be closing that door very soon. We have established our club in the MC world with total separation from the
